Chèche Ostara:

This scarf from the tip to go wider, it alternates strips of 3 diagonal stitches garter and stockinette stitch to give a visual impression of the rafters. This model can be knitted in any quality wool color is simple and well put very colorful son values, they make a harlequin or stripes. Ostara is the celebration of the spring equinox, renewal of life, so do not hesitate and put color and life in your hands!

Material:

2 balls of Kunstgarn (color 20),

Needles 3.5mm, 2 stitch markers.

Points and abbreviations:

k: knit

p: purl

kfb: knit the same stitch forward and back= increase1

kbf: knit the same stitch back and forward = increase1

SKP : slip knit, pass over = 1 decrease

SK2P: slip 1, knit 2 together, pass over= 2 decreases.

K2tog: knit 2 together= 1 decrease.

M: stitch marker.

R:row

* ... *. Repeat pattern between * and * as many times as necessary to get either:

- The mesh that lie just before the first stitch marker and knit as indicated.

- At the end of the row.



Work:

Cast on 1 stitch

R1(right side of the work)knit the same stitch 3 times: forward, back and forward (3 stitches)

R2 (wrong side of the work): k3

R3: kfb k1, kbf (5 stitches)

R4: k5

R5: kfb, k3, kbf. (7 stitches)

R6: k3, M, p1,M, k3

R7 and all the odd rows: kfb, knit all the stitches, and make kbf in the last stitch of the row.

R8: k3, p1, M, p1, M, p1, k3

R10: k3, p2, M, p1, M, p2, k3

R12: k3, p3, M, k1, M, p3, k3

R14: k3, p3, k1, M, k1, M, k1, p3, k3

R16: k3, p3, k2, M, k1, M, k2, p3, k3

R18: k3, p3, k3, M, p1, M, k3, p3, k3

R20: k3, p3, k3, p1 M, p1, M, p1, k3, p3, k3

R22: k3, p3, k3, p2 M, p1, M, p2, k3, p3, k3

R24: *k3, p3* M, k1, M,* p3, k3*.

R 25, 27, 29, 31, 33 and 35 = row 7.

R26: * k3, p3* k1, M, k1, M, k1* p3, k3*.

R28: * k3, p3* k2, M, k1, M, k2* p3, k3*.

R30: * k3, p3* k3, M, p1, M, k3* p3, k3*.

R32: * k3, p3* k3, p1, M, p1, M, p1, k3* p3, k3*.

R34: * k3, p3* k3, p2, M, p1, M, p2, k3* p3, k3*

Repeat rows 24-35 included as many times as necessary to get to 207 stitches (or more if you want a bigger shawl), when you are at 207 st, do the row 1 of the next part:

R1, 3, 5, 7, 9, and 11: SKP, *k*, K2tog.

R2: *k3, p3*, k3,p1, M, p1, M, p1, k3, *p3, k3*

R4: *k3, p3* k3, M, p1, M, k3, *p3, k3*

R6: *k3, p3*,k2 M, k1, M, k2*p3, k3*

R8: *k3, p3*, k1 M, k1, M, k1, *p3, k3*

R10: *k3, p3*, M, k1, M, *p3, k3*

R12: *k3, p3*, k3, p2, M, p1, M,p2, k3, *p3, k3*

Repeat as many times as necessary these 12 rows.

When there is 19 stitches:

R1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15 and 17 (right side row): SKP, *k*, K2tog

R2: k3, p3, k2, M, k1, M, k2, p3, k3.

R4: k3, p3, k1, M, k1, M, k1, p3, k3.

R6: k3, p3, M, k1, M, p3, k3.

R8: k3, p2, M p1, M, p2, k3.

R10: k3, p1, M p1, M, p1, k3

R12: k3, M p1, M, k3

R14: k5

R16: k3

R18: SK2P

R19: bind off the last stitch.

Make 4 tassels (or 4 pompons or put beads As please !!) and attach them to the 4 ends of the scarf . Wash and block. Bring in the threads and cut them short, wear !!
